

# DIRECTIONS: e@b city church and conference centre [www.elimbristol.org](http://www.elimbristol.org)

## COMING FROM THE NORTH ON M5/M4 TO BRISTOL

- From M5 exit at Junction 15 for M4 London (east).
- On M4 take first exit Junction 19 onto M32.
- Travel to end of M32 (just over 4 miles) and approaching traffic lights keep in right hand lane until you reach St James Barton Roundabout (Premier Travel Inn straight ahead).
- Take the fourth exit off the roundabout as if you are coming back on yourself.
- Immediately to your left is the entrance to St James Barton NCP (see large silvery star shaped sculpture at approach to car park). e@b stewards will be waiting to welcome and direct you to the Church (5 minute walk - see map).

## COMING FROM THE SOUTH ON M5 TO BRISTOL

- From M5 exit at Junction 18.
- On reaching traffic lights get in middle lane taking second exit for Bristol heading for City Centre.
- Continue on A4 Portway road for approximately five miles (river Avon on your right) travelling through a number of traffic lights then passing under the Clifton Suspension Bridge.
- At next set of traffic lights keep in left hand lane and continue onto Hotwell Road (one way system]. You will then see SS Great Britain and the river on right hand side.
- On reaching roundabout take first exit left (Jacobs Wells Road) and drive to top of hill.
- Move into the one way system getting into the right hand lane and filter right at the traffic lights, which brings you onto Queens Road.
- Move over to left hand lane and follow road through numerous sets of traffic lights (Sainsbury's, Bristol University, Museum, Bristol Royal Infirmary) until you reach St James Barton roundabout.
- Take second exit at roundabout signposted and marked on the road M32.
- Immediately to your left is the entrance to St James Barton NCP (see large silvery star shaped sculpture at approach to car park). e@b stewards will be waiting to welcome and direct you to the Church (5 minute walk - see map).

## COMING FROM BATH A4 TO BRISTOL (from outskirts of Bath A4 dual carriageway Bristol Road)

- Move into right hand lane and take second exit at roundabout A4 Bristol.
- Travel through Salford and take third exit at next roundabout onto Keynsham By Pass A4.
- Continue on by pass and at next roundabout take second exit A4 Bath Road.
- Continue on A4 for several miles through a number of traffic lights and a short one way section (Eagle Road) then fork right at the traffic lights at the bottom of the hill onto St Philips Causeway A4320.
- Passing Sainsbury's on the right, take first exit at next roundabout A4320.
- Continue on A4320 and take second exit at the next two roundabouts running into Easton Way.
- Take first exit at next roundabout (junction 3) to join the end of the M32 (Newfoundland Way).
- Keep in right hand lane through traffic lights until you reach St James Barton Roundabout (Premier Travel Inn straight ahead).
- Take the fourth exit off the roundabout as if you are coming back on yourself.
- Immediately to your left is the entrance to St James Barton NCP (see large silvery star shaped sculpture at approach to car park). e@b stewards will be waiting to welcome and direct you to the Church (5 minute walk - see map).
