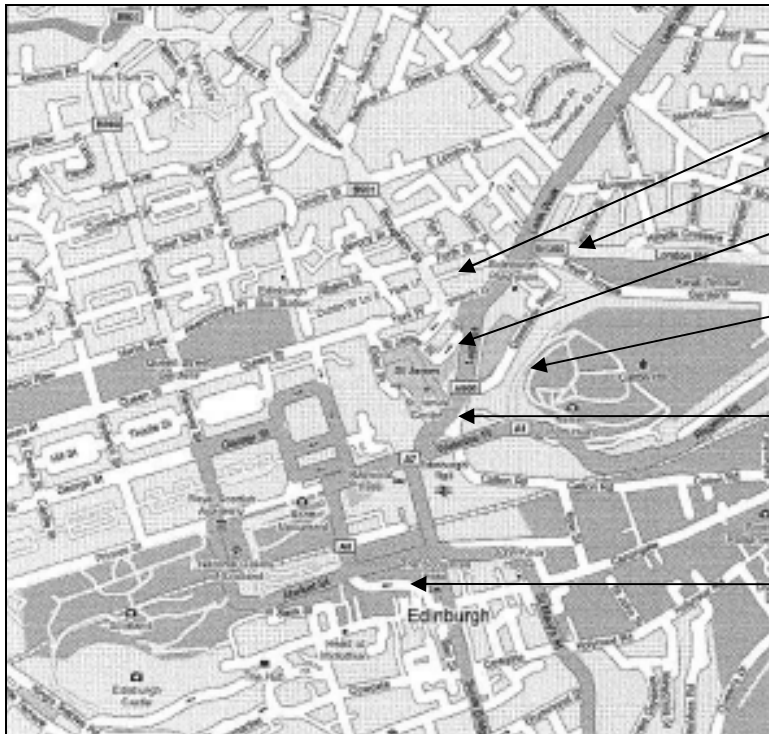

DIRECTIONS TO ST PAUL'S AND ST GEORGE'S CHURCH

Car parking in Edinburgh City Centre is difficult. Alternatives include:

- Park and ride facilities close to the city by-pass at several places to the west, south and east of the City.
- St Paul's and St George's church is a ten minute walk or a short taxi ride from Edinburgh Waverley Station.

If you do take the car, there are two car parks near to the church: in the St James Centre and in the Omni centre.

Because of tram works in Edinburgh City Centre, diversions are in force and are subject to changes at very short notice. The following directions avoid the traffic diversions in the City Centre.

COMING FROM THE WEST ON M8 TO EDINBURGH

- Exit M8 at junction 1 for Edinburgh City By-Pass South (A720).
- After approx 8km leave city by-pass at fifth junction (A701) for City Centre.
- Follow A701 for further 8km into city to T-junction at Princes Street (after crossing bridge over Waverley Station).
- Turn right and immediately left down Leith Street to Car Park on left.
- Exit car park, go left past Catholic Cathedral.
- Cross York Place to St Paul's and St George's Church.

COMING FROM NORTH WEST ON M9

- At end of M9 continue towards M8 for Edinburgh.
- At first junction go left on to M8 for Edinburgh.
- Exit M8 at junction 1 for Edinburgh City by-pass south (A720).
- After approx 8km leave city by-pass at fifth junction (A701) for City Centre.
- Follow A701 for further 8km into city to T-junction at Princes Street (after crossing bridge over Waverley Station).
- Turn right and immediately left down Leith Street to Car Park on left.
- Exit car park, go left past Catholic Cathedral.
- Cross York Place to St Paul's and St George's Church.

COMING FROM NORTH ON M90 (FORTH ROAD BRIDGE)

- From Forth Road Bridge follow A8000 for Glasgow not A90.
- A8000 runs directly on to M9.
- Follow directions above for coming in on M9.

COMING FROM SOUTH/EAST ON A1

- Leave A1 at Edinburgh City By-Pass (signed for Airport).
- At roundabout (after approx 4km) take third exit (A720 City Bypass).
- Leave city bypass at second junction (A701) for Edinburgh.
- Follow A701 for further 8km into city to T-junction at Princes Street (after crossing bridge over Waverley Station).
- Turn right and immediately left down Leith Street to Car Park on left.
- Exit car park, go left past Catholic Cathedral.
- Cross York Place to St Paul's and St George's Church.
