

DIRECTIONS TO RISING BROOK BAPTIST CHURCH

APPROACHING FROM M6

Leave M6 at JUNCTION 13 and take the A449 north into Stafford. Continue straight ahead through the traffic lights, passing an ESSO garage on the right. Take the first left into Hesketh Road where parking stewards will be positioned to direct you. There is strictly no parking for conference delegates in front of the Church but there is a car park behind the building and parking stewards will direct you to other parking areas.

APPROACHING FROM STAFFORD TOWN CENTRE

Take the A449 south towards Wolverhampton and continue south over the railway bridge. Go through the next set of traffic lights and take the first right into John Amery Drive. There is strictly no parking for conference delegates in front of the Church but there is a car park behind the building and parking stewards will direct you to other parking areas.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

There are many connections to Stafford Railway Station being situated on a main line route. On arrival, there is a taxi rank directly outside the station or, alternatively, it is a short walk to catch a No 8 bus to the Church [see below].

ARRIVING BY COACH

National Express coaches stop outside the Railway Station. There is a taxi rank directly outside the station or, alternatively, it is a short walk to catch a No 8 bus to the Church [see below].

BY BUS WALKING FROM THE RAILWAY STATION

Take the road at the mini roundabout heading away from the train lines and into town. Proceed across the next mini roundabout and continue down a wide pedestrian area between the buildings. Turn left at Earl Street and there are bus stops on the other side of the street. Take a No 8 ARRIVA bus to John Amery Drive marked MOSS PIT on the front of the bus. Do not catch a No 8 bus marked PARKSIDE.
